Audition Procedure: Musicals

*Everyone auditioning must complete Rounds 1 & 2. Round 3 is by invitation only.
Check the website for audition dates and time, rehearsal dates, and show dates.
Please do not audition if you cannot be present at all performances!*

Round 1: Singing Auditions

1. Download and print the APPLICATION (available at LHHSdrama.com). Fill out the application and bring it to your audition.
2. SIGN UP FOR AUDITION TIME using the link to the Google Doc. (Look for link on the website: LHHSdrama.com)
3. Prepare approximately one minute of a song that shows off your voice. You should perform the song as you would do a monologue, playing a specific character with defined objectives. Songs from musical theater are strongly recommended. You may use your phone or other device for recorded accompaniment (but please don't use one with someone else's voice singing the song) or you can sing a capella (i.e., without accompaniment).
4. Arrive 10-15 minutes before your scheduled audition time and plan to stay about 30 minutes.
5. You will also be asked to sing a round (such as "Row, Row, Row Your Boat") with a group of 3-4 other students to test your ability to hold harmonies.
6. HAVE CONFIDENCE in yourself and RELISH the experience!!

Round 2: Dance auditions

Wear comfortable shoes and clothes! Come even if you don't consider yourself a dancer and plan to stay the entire time! You will learn and perform a dance combination (in a group). Look for the video of the dance combo on the LHHSdrama.com website so you can prepare for the dance!

Round 3: Callbacks

If you are invited to a callback, expect to sing selections from the show, perform a 1-2 minute monologue, and possibly improvise scenes or read from the script. This part of the audition is done in groups of people being considered for a certain part. Plan to stay the entire time for which you are called.
